

AFTERCARE:

Immediate Care (First 24-48 Hours):

- **Monitor the Test Area:** Keep a close eye on the test site for up to 48 hours. Look for any signs of redness, swelling, itching, or irritation. These reactions are normal for some individuals but should not persist beyond 48 hours.
- **Avoid Scratching or Rubbing:** Do not scratch, rub, or apply pressure to the patch test area. This can worsen irritation and delay the healing process.
- **Keep the Area Clean and Dry:** For the first 24 hours, avoid getting the test area wet. If the area becomes wet, gently pat it dry with a clean towel.
- **Avoid Makeup or Creams:** Refrain from applying makeup, lotions, or creams to the test area for at least 24 hours to avoid irritation or infection.

Signs to Watch For:

- **Mild Reactions:** Itching, redness, or slight swelling at the test site are common and typically resolve on their own within a few hours to a day.
- **More Severe Reactions:** If you experience blistering, severe redness, swelling, or intense itching, it may indicate an allergic reaction. In this case, please remove any product from the area and contact your practitioner immediately.
- **Eye Irritation:** If the product comes into contact with your eyes, flush the area immediately with clean water. If irritation persists, seek medical attention.

When to Seek Medical Attention:

If any of the following symptoms occur, seek immediate medical advice:

- Severe redness, swelling, or discomfort at the patch test site that does not improve within 48 hours.
- Development of a rash, hives, or blisters.
- Excessive irritation, burning, or pain in the treated area.
- Swelling or irritation around the eyes, if the product has come into contact with your eyes.

If No Reaction Occurs:

- If you do not experience any adverse reactions after 48 hours, it is safe to proceed with your full brow treatment (e.g., tinting, waxing, or threading).
- Please schedule your brow treatment with your practitioner at your convenience.

Important Notes:

- **Contact Your Practitioner:** If you have any concerns or experience unusual reactions, please contact your practitioner as soon as possible for further advice.
- **New Product Testing:** For future brow treatments, it is recommended to perform a patch test for any new products or treatments to ensure continued safety.
