

AFTERCARE:

Immediate Care (First 24-48 Hours):

- **Monitor the Test Area:** Carefully observe the area where the test was applied (usually behind the ear or on the inner forearm). If you notice any redness, swelling, itching, or irritation, take note of the symptoms and contact your practitioner.
- **Avoid Scratching:** Do not scratch or rub the test area. This can increase irritation or make any potential reaction worse.
- **Keep Area Clean and Dry:** Avoid getting the patch test area wet for the first 24 hours. If the area becomes wet, gently pat it dry with a clean, soft towel.
- **Avoid Cosmetics:** Do not apply makeup, creams, or lotions to the patch test site for at least 24 hours after the test.

Possible Reactions and When to Seek Help:

- **Redness, Swelling, or Itching:** A mild reaction such as redness, swelling, or itching is normal. However, if these symptoms persist beyond 24 hours or worsen, please contact your practitioner.
- **Severe Reaction:** If you experience significant swelling, blistering, severe itching, or an intense burning sensation, remove any products from the area and contact your practitioner immediately. If symptoms persist or become severe, seek medical attention.
- **Eye Irritation:** If the test area comes into contact with your eyes or if you notice any irritation in the eye area, flush the area with clean water immediately and contact your practitioner.

Post-Test Observation:

- **24-48 Hour Monitoring:** Please continue to monitor the test site for up to 48 hours after the patch test. If no adverse reactions (such as swelling, redness, or blistering) occur within this time, it is likely safe for you to proceed with a full lash extension procedure.
- **Reaction Confirmation:** If you experience any irritation after 48 hours, please contact your practitioner for further advice.

If No Reaction Occurs:

- If there is no irritation or adverse reaction after 48 hours, you are cleared to proceed with the full lash extension procedure.

- Please book your full lash extension appointment with your practitioner at your earliest convenience.

Important Notes:

- If you have any concerns or experience unusual symptoms after your patch test, contact your practitioner immediately. Early intervention can help prevent more serious reactions.
- We strongly recommend that you perform a patch test for every new lash extension adhesive product to ensure safety.
